THIS FORM CAN ONLY BE COMPLETED BY NATIONAL FLIGHT SERVICES PERSONNEL.

Importer's Declaration of U.S Goods is a required document for entering U.S Goods returned under Tariff heading 9801. Tariff heading 9801 is return of U.S Goods for repair & re-export allowing for duty free entry. This form **MUST** accompany all International Return/Repair shipments. Requests for this form to be completed should be accompanied by completed Foreign Shipper's Declaration, commercial invoice and any applicable information such as photo of data plate, warranty information, etc.
